Romania - A short intro

Romania is situated right at the junction of Central and South-eastern Europe; its Westernmost regions of Transylvania and Banat are historically and culturally part of Central Europe while the other regions belong to the South-Eastern European area. Romania covers an area of 238,400 sq. kilometers. In terms of population, it is the 7th largest country of the European Union.

Romania is a member of EU, therefore if you're a citizen of EU a simple ID card will be enough, no passport will be necessary. Visas will not be required for citizens of USA, Canada, Australia, all EU members, as well as more than 50 other countries.

Bucharest is the capital of Romania; with almost 2 million residents, it is EU's <u>6th largest city</u> in terms of population within city limits and one of the 20 largest urban areas in the union.

Cluj-Napoca, Transylvania's most important is a booming university hub with the strongest IT industry in Romania, cultural events, music festivals and sports and a fabulous night life.

Romania's country code is +40. The internet code is .ro Romania has the fastest download speed anywhere in the European Union.

The official language of the country is Romanian (a Romance language with a grammar which is similar to Latin, which makes it easier for speakers of French, Italian, Spanish or Portuguese to understand it.

Most Romanians from the new generation speak good English, some speak French while in Transylvania, German is rather popular. Getting directions should be easy in the major cities.

The second most spoken language in Romania is Hungarian. The Hungarian community is the most significant minority in Romania and represents a fifth of the total population of Transylvania.

Romania is a member of NATO since 2004 and a part of the European Union since 2007.

Apart from Bucharest, the biggest cities of Romania are Cluj-Napoca (324,000) and Timisoara: 319,000).
